## 2019 NCBBA Fall Tip-Off Tournament Registration Form

The NCBBA is excited to present the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual NCBBA Fall Tip-Off Tournament that will take place November 1-3, 2019. This year 16 of the elite NCBBA teams from the New England, North Atlantic, Mid Atlantic, and Great Lakes Regions will be invited to compete. Teams will start in Pool Play (4 Pools of 4 teams) with each team moving onto a Single Elimination Tournament, where the eventual champion will be crowned.

All games are 40 minutes in length (two 20 minute stopped clock halves) with a five minute halftime and will count as non-conference. Each registered team is guaranteed at least 4 games and all games will be refereed by high school certified officials. Every game will be played at C3 Sports Complex in State College, PA. The winner of the tournament will be awarded a trophy. Cost of the tournament is \$360 (\$450 for non NCBBA teams) which covers all court usage, officials and basketballs for the tournament. A \$150 nonrefundable deposit must be made by August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to ensure a spot in the tournament. The remaining balance is due no later than September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019. **We will accept the first 16 teams that register.** This will fill up fast, so act quickly. BUT...before signing and sending in, please read the commitments you are agreeing to.

## Tournament Guidelines

### Rules

- 1) All games played will be governed by the 2019-2020 NCBBA-M rule book.
- 2) Seeding for the single elimination round will be determined using the Pool Standing Tiebreakers.

The following criteria will be used to determine pool standing:

- The first criterion for determining pool standing is pool-play winning percentage.
- Two Team Tiebreaker
  1. In any situation where two teams are tied, head-to-head competition between the teams shall determine the winner.
- Three Team Tiebreaker
  1. If more than two teams are tied, a point differential tie breaker will be applied. The point differentials of the teams involved in the tie are totaled. Teams are then ranked according to the sum of the point differential and the team with the highest ranking is determined the pool play winner. *\*In the event of a three-way tie, should this tiebreaker eliminate one team, and leave the other two teams tied, then the head to head result of the remaining two teams will determine the pool champion.*
  2. If more than two teams are still tied after the application of the point differential formula, the higher seed is rewarded to the team with the fewest combined points scored against them. *\*In the event of a three-way tie, should this tiebreaker eliminate one team, and leave the other two teams tied, then the head to head result of the remaining two teams will determine the pool champion.*
  3. If more than two teams are still tied after the application of Step Two, a three-way flip of the coin shall break the tie, with the odd team being declared the pool winner. The tie between the two remaining teams shall be broken based on the results of their head-to-head competition.

### Other items:

Be at your game a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the official start time of your game. Game times may be moved up if the previous game finishes early. Be in touch with the director for the most up to date start time.

Teams must provide one volunteer to work the scorer's table for each game (scoreboard or score sheet).

The NCBBA will provide game balls for the tournament. **\*Teams will need to bring their own basketballs to warm up with before games\***

Water will be available but teams are encouraged to bring their own water bottles.

Keep in mind you are representing not only yourselves and your university but the NCBBA as well. Act responsibly at the fields and at the hotel.
