SUNY Oswego & SUNY Binghamton-GREEN Player Suspensions

After reviewing all information provided to the league, the NCBBA has suspended the following players for their participation in an on-court physical altercation during their matchup on November 3rd.

- SUNY Binghamton-Green #21: Suspended 3 games for making physical contact with an opponent and another 1 game suspension for failing to leave the facility. Suspended 4 games total.
- SUNY Oswego #3: Suspended 3 games for making physical contact with an opponent and another 1 game suspension for failing to leave the facility. Suspended 4 games total.
- SUNY Oswego #4: Suspended 1 game.
- SUNY Oswego #6: Suspended 3 games for making physical contact with an opponent.
- SUNY Oswego #7: Suspended 3 games for making physical contact with an opponent and another 1 game suspension for failing to leave the facility. Suspended 4 games total.

After an initial physical altercation between two opposing players, both teams, including their benches became involved in several a physical altercation that took place during the 2nd half of the 1st game of the series. One such altercation left a SUNY Binghamton player knocked unconscious with criminal charges filed.

This type of behavior is not, and will not be tolerated. The NCBBA is a legitimate organization and takes great pride in its on-court product produced by its amazing member institutions and student-athletes. When incidents like this occur, it diminishes that legitimacy.

Note: Per NCBBA Rules, the games resulted in a double-forfeited tie.
